Realife is a non-denominational, gospel centered Christian Camp and retreat center with two locations at either end of the sunshine state, Realife Blue Springs, and Vero Beach. Summer Camp with a Mission

Realife has a passion to 'Reach the Unreached' of the next generation. We are alarmed at the growing number of teens in our society that have lost hope and suffer from abandonment, addiction, depression, and abuse. This camp presents a unique and extraordinary opportunity to make a difference in the lives of young people.

We will sponsor about 750 young people this summer that are from the Foster Care System. We then solicit businesses, churches, and individuals to help provide scholarships. These young people will come from the Florida Coalition for Children, Florida Department of Children & Families, and Florida Foster & Adoptive Parent Association. There will be at least one of these young people in each cabin during all camp weeks. This provides church youth groups and individuals with an amazing opportunity to be missionaries to unreached young people that need Jesus! Because of this focus, Realife has been characterized as a summer camp and a mission trip all rolled into one!

While at camp, we ask that you love these young people unconditionally so that you may see what God can do through you! This mission effort has resulted in thousands of young people coming to Christ and has been the catalyst that has ushered in revival in many churches youth groups.

Registration, Payments, and Financial Policy

- **Individual Registration** –When you submit your individual registration, you will receive a confirmation email that contains the specific details of your registration as well as terms and conditions. Please download and print this confirmation email to keep a copy of your registration for your records.
- **Refunds**– We will refund your camp payment less a \$50 deposit up to 30 days prior to your camp date. After this 30-day window there are no refunds. This refund policy is only for individual campers that are not part of a group.
- **First Come First Served**– All registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis by registering online at www.reallife.org Phone conversations, email communications, text messages and online inquiries do not secure camp dates.
- Adults and students are both required to pay the camp fees. The camp fee includes room, board, all activity supplies, and a camp t-shirt. There are no additional fees or charges other than your designated camp fee.
- **Snack Shack** – Your camp week will include a snack shack that we will open at certain times as scheduled by Realife. This snack bar has various popular drinks and snacks for sale with the typical soda or candy items costing \$1-\$3. The items in the snack bar are not included in the camp fee but can be purchased separately. You have two options for payment of these snack bar items: A. Your student can pay with cash or with credit card at the point of purchase or you can go to the Realife website at www.reallife.org and click on the button that says "Put money in my Snack Shack account".
- **Snack Bar Payments**– Please note that if you decide to utilize the online payment option: 1. There will be a credit card transaction fee of 3% added to your online payment. B. Your student will be responsible for going to the snack bar and ask for a **cash refund** of unused snack shack funds prior to leaving the camp. **Realife does not provide refunds for unused snack shack funds after your student has left the camp property. By using this system, you are agreeing to this policy.**
- **Changes to Individual Registrations**–You will have an opportunity to register for activities, add t-shirt sizes and add roommate request at the time of individual online registration. After this registration is complete, all changes will need to be made at check-in, when camp begins. Please don't email or call with change requests.
- **Individual Registration Requirements**–All campers and adults attending Realife register individually online at www.reallife.org This registration can be done on a computer, tablet or, smartphone. These individual registrations are required for Realife to receive important information such as, activity choices, t-shirt sizes, and necessary parent and camper signatures.
- **Rooming Lists**– The specific cabin rooming list will be made by Realife. We are unable to send out the rooming list in advance because of last-minute cancellations or additions.
- **Rooming List Approval**–We will do our best to accommodate the rooming requests of individuals. Please provide any roommate requests on the online registration form. However, Realife reserves the right to set all rooming lists.
- **Weather**– Realife cannot be held responsible for weather during your camp week but we will do all that we reasonably can to make your stay enjoyable and continue with all scheduled camp activities.
- **Property Damage**– Participants or their guardians are responsible for intentional property and equipment damage excluding normal wear and tear.
